Jesus Tempted Off Course

Jesus was brought out of the ordinary into a place where he was tempted off course with three temptations - to comfort, power, and wealth - three things that can take us over.

Money, power and comfort can lead us astray....when we want wealth, to be number 1 and prioritise comfort in various ways. He goes back to the word of God to find strength and insight to fight off evilto the words he learned at home, and at school. A big source of energy for us is the word of God. On Ash Wednesday the invitation was to believe the good news. That is where we may find life and strength.




